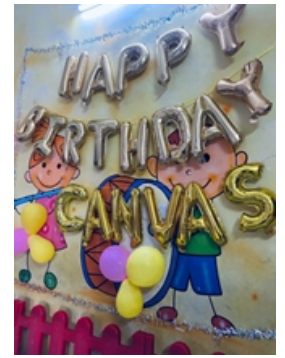


Foundation Day Celebration – Canvas Rise

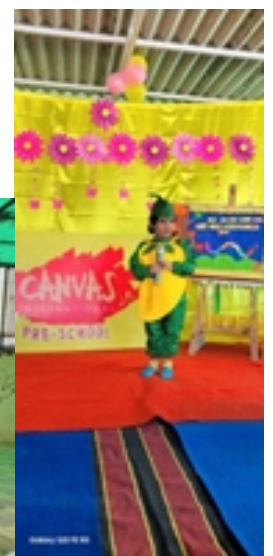


Culmination day

1. Canvins showcase their talents and skills learned throughout the year, such as singing, dancing, and reciting poems.

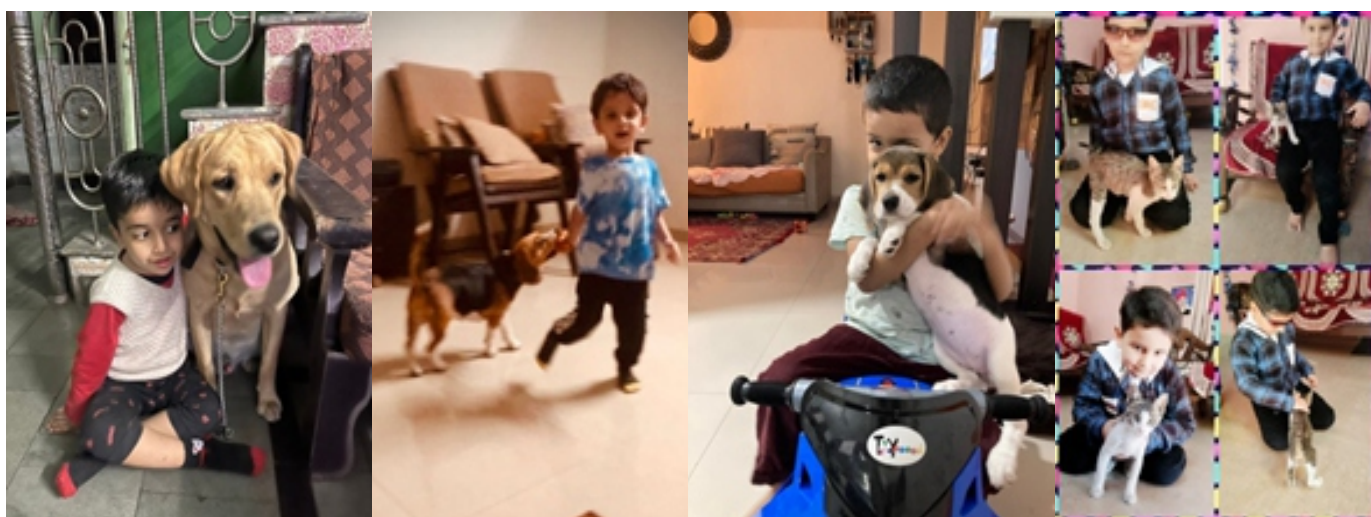


- Children can be presented with certificates of completion, acknowledging their hard work and dedication during the academic year.
