ELETS WORLD EDUCATION SUMMIT

At the 11th School Leadership Summit, Chandigarh, Ms. Hema Harchandani, Founder and Managing Director of Canvas International Preschool shared her experience at the panel discussion on Early Childhood Education in the Era of Digital Learning and Innovations during the Early Years.





LET'S TAKE A TOUR OF EACH SKILL:

1. Physical skills:

Fine motor skill which means the finger, thumb and wrist muscles. We need to develop these to help the child with writing properly in future.

How do we develop such skills at canvas?

Tearing, sticking, cutting, doodling, block play, puzzles, play doh, buttoning, threading and many more.



Gross motor skills mean the ability to walk, balance, jump, skip and hop. It is very essential to build a strong and healthy body.

How do we develop such skills at canvas?

Jungle gym, basketball, bat and ball, cars and scooter, balancing beams, throwing and catching activities, running and jumping activities etc.



Equipment available at Canvas for developing such skills?

Yes of course, we have been very selective and particular in our equipment selection.

2. Social skills:

The ability to share, wait for one's turn, think of other people's feelings. To say 'Good Morning' and 'Thank You', to learn to use toys and other equipment without breaking them, and to learn to put things back where they belong after using them are all part of social skills.

How do we develop such skills at canvas?

Through our free play activities our songs, poems, stories, puppets, our role play toys and our dramatic corner like doll house etc. and even during snack time and sand and water play time.



3. Emotional and Moral skills

Emotional skills

When these skills are developed a child learns not to throw tantrums, he or she learns not to cry when left at school, learns to think

about other's feelings, learns not to shout, and learns to listen.

Moral skills

Values like learning to take care of nature, learning to be truthful, learning to stand in a line etc. are all part of a child's moral development.



How do we develop such skills at canvas?

These skills are developed at Canvas through free play activities, songs, poems, stories, puppets, role play toys, dramatic corner like doll house etc. and even during snack time.

4. Language skills

Colour recognition, ability to recognize same and different, ability to follow a sequence, ability to find matching pictures and ability to recite names and remember them are all part of language skills

How do we develop such skills at canvas?

Picture matching and shape matching puzzles, sequence cards and games. picture talk, songs, stories, matching activities, etc.

At Canvas this is done with puppets, special flash cards. picture talk, sand play games, water play games, puzzles role play etc. hence a strong foundation is laid for future reading and language skills.

5. Thinking skills

Thinking skills are required for developing mathematical and logical skills which help the child with learning mathematics and science better.

These skills can be developed with the Montessori equipment, sorters, puzzles, obstacle courses, matching activities, and sequencing activities etc.

At Canvas they are developed by Montessori equipment like pink towers, blocks, smell and sound tablets etc. and activities like what comes after and before, what will happen now is done through picture talk, sorting and grading.





TALK ON DOCTORS' DAY:

The first Doctors' Day observance was held on March 30, 1993 in Winder, Georgia. The idea came from Eudora Brown Almond, wife of Dr. Cha Almond, and the date was the anniversary of the first use of general anaesthetic in surgery. On March 30, 1842, Dr. Crawford Long of Barrow County, Georgia, used ether to remove a tumour from a patient's neck.


The Barrow County Medical Society Auxiliary proclaimed the day as 'Doctors' Day', which was celebrated by mailing cards to physicians and their wives, and placing flowers on the graves of deceased doctors.

In India, National Doctors' Day is celebrated on the birth anniversary of Dr. B.C. Roy who was born on July 1. He was a highly respected physician and renowned for his diagnosis. He was devoted towards his patients and contributed significantly for making modern medical facility available to common people.



professional organisation in the country. Medical Council of India, the governing body of Allopathic Medicine, was his brain child, and he was its first president in 1939, the position he held till 1945.

Besides, being a doyen of medical profession, he was also a great humanitarian, Vice Chancellor of Calcutta, University and Chief Minister of Bengal.



The US House of Representatives adopted a resolution commemorating Doctors' Day on March 30, 1958. In 1990, legislation was introduced in the House of Representatives and Senate to establish National Doctors' Day. Then, President George Bush designated March 30 as National Doctors' Day.

Dr. Roy's contribution to medical profession and Indian Medical Association are immense. He played a key role in establishing Indian Institute of Mental Health, Infective Disease Hospital and first ever post graduate medical college in Calcutta. He was instrumental in starting Indian Medical Association in the year 1928 and making it the largest

The illustrious life and achievements of Dr. B.C. Roy in the course of medical profession, the society and the country, he was bestowed with India's top civilian honour Bharat Ratna in 1961. Recognizing his services the Govt. of India declared July 1st as National Doctors' Day in India.

Doctors' Day is celebrated recognising the tireless efforts of physicians around the nation. The Day provides a time for people to show appreciation to the doctors who care for them and their loved ones.

Canvas students and teachers gathered and celebrated Labour Day by being grateful and giving thanks to all the support staff.




