LESSONS ON PARENTING FROM CHANDRAYAAN-2 LANDING

- Appreciate the process.
 That's what the nation is doing today. We are seeing the hard work of scientists.
 Parenting is similar. Focus on the process of learning of your child. Results will vary.


CURRICULUM CORNER
