
ACTIVITIES HELD


AWARDS - PRINCIPALS AND TEACHERS AWARDS

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TIPS TO HELP YOUR CHILD FALL IN LOVE WITH READING

How to bring reading into your child's life?

Reading is good for kids. When books are part of the family routine, kids' language skills grow. Books can also help parents teach important values and understand difficult events in real life. They can read alone or you can make it a family affair.

Here are some tips to bring love of reading into your child's life.

· MODEL GOOD READING BEHAVIOR:

If kids see you reading, they will be more likely to pick up a book themselves.

· READ TOGETHER BEFORE BEDTIME:

Get quality time together at the end of the day. Reading out loud help kids bring the words to life. Talk about the story together. Ask questions like "What do you thinkwill happen next?" You can switch things up some nights and ask your school-age child to read a book to you!

· READ WHAT THEY READ:

Follow their interests by keeping up with what your kids read. It makes it more fun and gives you something enjoyable to talk about.

· ALL READING IS GOOD READING:

Let kids know that reading is great no matter what they're interested in. Anything goes fiction, biographies, kids' magazines, comic books or even reading a cookbook in the kitchen!

· CREATE A READING NOOK:

A cozy, snuggle-friendly area in your home can be turned into the family "reading zone." Just add blankets, pillows, a bean bag chair, and a lamp!



READ WITH FRIENDS:

A book club with friends can give kids a way to share and learn about different views. If local public health guidelines allow, put on your cloth face covering, and find an open area for a physically distanced meet-up. Kids can talk about a book, their favorite characters, or how they think the book could have ended differently.

· KEEP BOOKS AROUND:

If there's always a book within reach, kids will be more likely to pick one up and read, even for a few minutes at a time.

TRAVEL WITH READING MATERIAL:

Bring books for car rides or waiting to see a doctor. Books are a great option instead of a tablet or a smart phone.

· A GIFT THAT KEEPS GIVING:

Friends and family can give the gift of books for a birthday or a holiday. Make it personal by asking the gift-giver to write a message inside the book cover. Your child can cherish the book and message from a loved one for years to come.

Remember, keep reading to your child and with your child after they learn how to read.
Continuing to read together brings strong, lasting connections throughout their childhood.





CURRICULUM CORNER

Maria Montessori observed that children learn more from their surroundings. Maria Montessori questioned the traditional way of teaching and felt that if a child wants to move, the child should be provided with a school that allows him/her to move. The Montessori Teaching Method involves creating a suitable environment for the children wherein they can teach themselves. The five principles of Montessori Method are - Practical Life. Sensorial, Mathematics, Language and Culture. It is based on self - directed activities, hands - on learning and collaborative play. The following pedagogies of Montessori Method are adopted by the Canvas International Pre-School, as they are the foundation principles of the Montessori Teaching Methods which defines and differentiates it from the traditional method of teaching.

- 1. Experiential Learning Children learn with using specially designed material. Instead of rot learning a concept or numbers, they understand the concept with the help of objects.
- 2. Mixed Age Classrooms The age groups have been divided into three categories. Mixed age classrooms help in solidifying knowledge for young toddlers by observing their older peers.
- 3. Uninterrupted Work Period Montessori

- classrooms have time duration of 2–3 hours depending on the age group rather than 30 minutes for each subject. It helps the child in engaging with the material deeply.
- 4. Role of the Teacher Instead of calling them a teacher, it is preferred to call them as a 'Guide'. Because Maria Montessori believed that a teacher's profile is to introduce the materials to the child, and guide one on one rather than addressing a large group.
- 5. Freedom within Limits A child has the freedom to choose the subject he/she would like to study but within certain limits.
- 6. Educating the Whole Child Montessori focuses on educating the whole child, including physical, spiritual, social, mental and emotional education.
- 7. Individualized Curriculum In a class of 20, it is understood that each child would be on a different level academically which is tracked by the teacher.
- 8. Prepared Environment The classrooms are designed in a way where there are all the materials which the child can explore at his/her own pace.
- 9. Peace Education Montessori Method aims at building a sense of sensitivity in the child for their community to spread peace.
