Researchers and early childhood educators both view the parents as an integral part of the early childhood education process. Often educators refer to parents as the child's "first and best teacher."

Much of the first two years of a child's life is spent in the creation of a child's first "sense of self"; most children are able to differentiate between themselves and others by their second year. This is a crucial part of the child's ability to determine how they should function in relation to other people.

Early care must emphasize links to family, home culture, and home language by uniquely caring for each child. Infant education is the education of children before they would normally enter school. The term "Infant" is typically applied to children between the ages of 1 month and 12 months.

Early childhood education focuses on children's learning through play, based on the research and philosophy of Jean Piaget. This belief is centered on the "power of play."It has been thought that children learn more efficiently and gain more knowledge through play-based activities such as dramatic play, art, and social games. This theory stems children's natural curiosity and tendencies to "make believe," mixing in educational lessons.

Dersonality

It's no big secret that getting kids involved in the stage activities can have major payoffs. In Canvas International Pre-school we believe that children who sing/dance/act/play their little hearts out are four times more likely to be recognized for academic achievement compared to non-performing kids. They tend to have enhanced cognitive, motor, and social development, but the benefits don't end there. Going up on stage can enrich your child's life in surprising ways. School gave kids a chance to participate in "KIDS FASHION SHOW" where children not only performed at school level, but on state level.







LANGAUGE DEVELOPMEMT (RHYMING)



Rhyming is a precursor to learning how to read and write.

We believe that teaching rhyming is important for so many reasons! To begin with, a multitude of research has shown a correlation between rhyming mastery and eventual reading readiness. We incorporate more rhyming activities every day (fruit names, vegetable names, etc.). On top of that, rhyming helps kids improve their oral language skills overall. It helps them to playfully manipulate their language, which gives them a kind of "permission" to manipulate language in other ways. Children have more ownership over their language when they're encouraged to change it and play with how they speak, rhyming is an aspect of phonemic awareness (awareness of how to listen, to identify, and change around the sounds in spoken language). Phonemic awareness lays the groundwork for written language.
